
Message from the Editorial Board

Since its inception in 2008 as part of, the journal has been published 4 times a year. This year marks our 15th anniversary. The journal has upheld the high standards of research excellence, with all manuscripts subjected to stringent peer review procedures. Our reviewers are world-class scientists, many of them leading their own research teams. Our papers are indexed by both Russian (RSCI) and international databases such as Scopus and Web of Science.
